Content of Sessions:

Each class of Saturday Math will feature several Number Talks—these are 10-minute mental math routines designed to help your child build their procedural fluency in mastering and thinking flexibly about numbers.

Children grades K-6 will focus develop their ability to problem solve and communicate their mathematical thinking. Children will continue to develop number sense and conceptual understanding of numbers and operations. Each child will experience and create multiple representations of mathematical situations to deepen their understanding of the underlying mathematical connections involved.

Highlighted Faculty:

Kathleen Giordano has been with the Saturday Math program for 31 years and has 32 years of successful teaching in Delaware and New Jersey schools. She teaches the youngest students in the Saturday Math program to really get them excited and confident about learning!
